

Status and Registration Clarification

A Breeder's Agreement to Co-Ownership on a dog or bitch is a contractual agreement between two parties. It is your responsibility to resolve any agreements with your breeder and/or co-owner.

The Club Registry will allow the registration of such dogs if they are currently registered with the ISSR. The progeny of these dogs will only be registered if both the parents and the litter meet the Club Registry Requirements.

Should you elect to register your dog with the Club Registry, you need to remember that the ISSR does not accept dual registration and according to their rules dual registered dogs must be removed from their registry. The ISSR will not recognize any progeny produced from dogs not solely registered with the ISSR.

If the Breeder/Co-Owner is a member of the ISSDC and also has their dog registered with the Club Registry, there will be no problem in honoring these agreements.

Any Co-Ownership agreements between two ISSDC members will require the signatures of both members for litter registration.

Any Co-Ownership agreements involving an ISSDC member and a non-member will require only the signature of the member for litter registration.
