#### To Apply For Adult Registration:

The enclosed pink-bordered certificate of registration, showing the PIN registration number prefix is valid for fourteen (14) months from the date of birth of the dog. The owner of this dog must apply for adult registration when the dog is between twelve (12) and fourteen (14) months of age, unless an extension request was submitted to the ISSR, Inc. Extensions are valid for six (6) months and must be resubmitted as necessary prior to thirty (30) months of age.

- Send the ISSR, Inc:
  - a. A copy of OFA or PennHIP report (Black/white upgrades only; a hip x-ray in the proper OFA position with correct labeling is needed)

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### Instructions for Filling out the Dominants and Recessives Genetics Virtues and Faults Chart

Enclosed you will find a chart that you will need to fill out for each dog that you own when applying for his/her permanent registration certificate. Please be honest in your evaluation. If you are not sure, please contact your breeder or a VIB who can assist you.

This information will be entered into the TCCP database and is very critical to the future welfare of our breed! Please take the time to read the following suggestions carefully.

- Please print or type in all of your dog's information in the appropriate spaces on the enclosed form.
- Look at the enclosed chart, read items 1-81 carefully and then concentrate on your dog. Now go back to the chart and circle the faults that apply to your dog. Then circle the virtues. Please note: Items 71-81 are possible recessive traits only. Please do not use them as a dominant (what you can visually see) trait.
- Now you need to choose 7 numbers out of 81 that best describe your dog. Please list them in order of their importance.

**Example:** Start by looking at your dog's head. Does it look "bitchy", e.g., extremely narrow like a Collie? Do his ears "kite out", e.g., stick out to the sides? Does he have a bad bite? Or does he look alert and noble? Does he have a broad head? Are his eyes round or almond shaped? What is the biggest fault you see in your dog? Is he perfect in structure except having a hooked tail? Study the Illustrated Breed Standard and then view your dog carefully! What is the number one most important feature your dog possesses? Could it be his excellent herding ability? Is he heavy boned but tall? Then you would pick #60. If he is heavy boned but short and stocky, then you would list #59. Is he thin but very tall? Then you would list #62, etc.

Now, concentrate on his/her littermates. Think about them carefully. What strong characteristics did they possess?
What faults did they have? Talk to their owners and ask your breeder. If you are not sure, investigate! Part 2 of the
Dominants and Recessives chart is extremely important. This information can be very critical to any further breeding
program that your dog or his progeny or littermates may be involved in. Honest data will help us to produce better
Shiloh Shepherds.

You must call your breeder, talk to the people who own your dog's littermates. Investigate. Did any of your dog's littermates have soft ears? Bad hips? Spooky temperaments? Did they all meet size requirements? Be honest! List these faults and virtues in order of importance under "Recessives". There is no such thing as a perfect dog. You must list your dog's dominants and recessive faults in order to protect the future of our breed!

Please note: if your dog had his tail amputated in a car door accident, he does not carry a genetic factor for short tails. If your dog was abused as a puppy and is now afraid of men with beards, #38 does not apply. Please use the extra space provided for your comments. If in doubt, please enclose a picture and/or explanation.

Above all else, please try to understand that this program is designed for the future well being of our breed! If your dog has kite ears, but fantastic hips, super intelligence, huge size, etc., that does not mean that your dog should not be bred. What it does mean is that your dog should not to be bred to another dog that has soft eared littermates! That's why the information in our computerized breeding profiles is so very important! Please do your part to help us maintain the absolute best standards possible!

The code numbers will be prefixed by either "DGC" for dominant characteristics or "RGC" for recessive characteristics (seven code limit).
